Online Program Offerings

M.Ed. in Educational Leadership

This master's level program is designed for PreK–12 teachers who want to become future principals, assistant principals, supervisors, district and state administrators, and teacher leaders.

M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction: Early Childhood Education

This comprehensive degree program prepares individuals to meet the educational, social, and emotional needs of children from birth through 8 years old.

M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction: Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

This degree program prepares professionals to work with individuals with special learning and behavior needs using the principles of applied behavior analysis. This program offers coursework pre-approved by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board for students interested in sitting for the Board Certified Behavior Analyst examination.

M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction: Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD)

This program equips individuals with specialized skills and knowledge to work effectively and compassionately with children and adults affected with autism.

M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction: Gifted Education

This degree program instills master's degree candidates with the knowledge and skills they need to recognize and nurture the full potential of gifted students by providing the most current instructional methods and services.

M.A. in Curriculum and Instruction: English as a Second Language (ESL)

This comprehensive degree program bridges academic theory and real-world practice to develop advocates who can help English language learners (ELL) cope with the social, cultural, and personal challenges associated with simultaneously mastering academic content and English language acquisition.

Ed.D. in Leadership and Innovation

ASU's Doctor of Education (EdD) in Leadership and Innovation is designed for practicing educator-leaders who work in a range of settings and want to lead change and implement innovation to improve their practice and create better learning opportunities for students of all ages.

Graduate Certificates in ABA, ASD, ESL, Gifted Education

ASU offers graduate certificates including Applied Behavior Analysis, an Overview of Autism Spectrum Disorders, Gifted Education, and English as a Second Language.

B.A.E. Educational Studies

M.A. in History
