

Teacher Salary Supplement Program (TSSP)

Summary Reference for JSD Administrators

The TSSP currently provides qualifying teachers for special education, mathematics, computer science and specifically identified science areas with an annual **\$4,100 salary supplement**.

Educators receive the full supplement if they are assigned full-time to teach one or more of the courses listed in statute and have a qualifying degree also listed in statute:

- Integrated science in 7th or 8th grades
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Computer Science, Computer Literacy, Systems Integration
- Math (Math 7, Math 8, Secondary Math, Algebra & IB math, Calculus, Statistics)
- Special Education

The Qualifying Educational Background **requires teachers to have a bachelor's degree major, master's degree, or doctoral degree in the content areas** listed in statute to qualify for a supplement. Teachers working less than a full-time assignment teaching in one of these courses may receive a partial salary adjustment based on the number of hours worked in the course.

Teachers must apply to USBE, **through the TSSP website** - <https://www.schools.utah.gov/curr/licensing/tssp>, in order to be considered for the salary supplement and teachers may apply after each semester/trimester or at the end of the school year.

Examples:

Teacher A: Teaches 6 periods math – would receive the full **\$4,100** stipend.
(1.0 qualifying courses x 1.0 FTE x \$4,100)

Teacher B: Teaches 4 periods math and 2 periods P.E. – would receive a **\$2,747** stipend.
(.67 qualifying courses (4/6) x 1.0 FTE x \$4,100)

Teacher C: Teaches 5 periods math and 2 periods P.E. – would receive a **\$3,416** stipend.
7th Period Allocation (.714 qualifying courses (5/7) x 1.167 FTE x \$4,100)
